She worked at Keahaven Nursing Home, which is now the Golden Living Center for many years. On December 10, 1977 she was united into marriage to Duane Reinke at Neligh, Ne and the couple made their home on the farm northeast of Clearwater. Duane passed away October, 1984. Bernice enjoyed cooking, gardening, canning, and quilting. Being with family was the most important part of her life. She was a member of the Concordia Lutheran Church for years. She then joined St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Orchard in 1998, when she moved to Orchard from the farm.
